Texas' Midstream Sector Congratulates Railroad Commissioner Christi Craddick on Recent Election to Chair the Agency

Prior to joining the Railroad Commission of Texas, she served as the chief political and legal advisor to the Speaker of the Texas House of Representatives, Tom Craddick, and was president of the grassroots advocacy firm Direct Contacts.
